



**Lausanne, October 31, 2006 – Results of preselection in Latin America :**



The third edition of the preselection jointly organised in Latin America with Ms **Cristina Sanchez**, *Director of the dance competition Danzamerica*, took place in Villa Carlos Paz (Cordoba) on October 7 to 11. **Sergiu Stefanschi**, *Ballet Master of the Canada's National Ballet*, delegate of the Prix de Lausanne, and **Maurizio Wainrot**, choreographer, *Director of the Contemporary Ballet del Teatro General San Martin in Buenos Aires*, were in charge of choosing the best candidates from among a group of 24 young dancers from Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay, who will be invited to participate in the competition in Lausanne, all expenses paid.

The level of preparation of the candidates was very satisfactory, and finally three young dancers were selected: *Kleber Rebello Moreira Neto, 15 years old, from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, Andrea Pamela Giménez Giménez, 18 years old, from Asuncion, Paraguay and Eloá Furtado, 17 years old, also from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.*
