Lausanne, May 10th, 2023: After the success of its 50th anniversary, the Prix de Lausanne has the pleasure to announce its return to South America since 2019 for the first back in-person *Latin American Preselection* for the Prix de Lausanne 2024, taking place in Córdoba, Argentina from September 30th to October 1st, 2023.

The *Latin American Preselection* offers a unique opportunity for young dancers from South America to be selected to participate in the Prix de Lausanne 2024. For two days, young dancers will take part in both classical and contemporary dance classes, and present variations to a Jury of South American dance professionals with exceptional international careers.
