## Prix de Lausanne 2025 Young Creation Award 2025 Finalists

International ballet competition for young dancers – Beaulieu Lausanne, Switzerland

Lausanne, 5 December 2024 : 5 young talents from the Prix de Lausanne partners schools and junior companies have been selected to participate in the 2025 Young Creation Award, on Wednesday 5 February 2025 at Beaulieu, Lausanne.

The Young Creation Award, a choreographic competition for young dancers from our partner schools, will be held for the fifth year running during the 53rd edition of the Prix de Lausanne, 2-9 February 2025. For this edition, **56 young choreographers** (**34 girls and 22 boys**) from **24 partner schools**, and **21 countries** submitted a variation, from which 5 were selected:

All variations will be presented during the Choreographic Evening, on Wednesday 5 February 2025, from which 2 winners will be selected by the Prix de Lausanne Jury. The 2 winning choreographies will then be presented during the Finals' Interlude, as well as on the Sunday, 9 February, during the *Rising Stars* event.

These variations will then be included in the Prix de Lausanne repertoire of contemporary variations for the 2026 edition.
